Toshihiro Yamakoshi joined the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport, and Tourism (MLIT) in 1992, after receiving a Bachelor of Law from the University of Tokyo.

After graduation, he worked as the Deputy Director of Air Traffic Services Planning Division, Air Navigation Services Department, for the Japan Civil Aviation Bureau or JCAB. In 1999, he became the Deputy Director of the Passenger Transport Division, Road Transport Bureau, before becoming the Senior Deputy Director of the Maritime Industries Division of the Maritime Bureau. He also worked as the Senior Deputy Director for the International Affairs Division, Policy Bureau. He progressed to the Director of the Office of Aeronautical Satellite Systems at the JCAB, before becoming the Director of the Office of Project Development for the Railway Bureau in 2011.

Starting in 2013 he was the Counsellor at the Embassy of Japan in New Delhi India, until he took his most recent position as Director of the Air Navigation Services Planning Division at the Civil Aviation Bureau in July of 2016.

Mr. Yamakoshi earned an LL.M. from Cornell Law School in 1996 and is an attorney-at-law admitted in the US.
