



### **Rina Cutler**

*Senior Director, Major Stations Planning and Development, Amtrak*

Rina Cutler began working at Amtrak in April of 2015 as the Senior Director of Major Stations Planning and Development. She is responsible for advancing large scale, multi-party master plans and development projects for Amtrak's largest stations in the Northeast Corridor and Chicago. In this role she is working with the development community to prepare for TOD and air rights development for the stations in her portfolio. These projects will seek to maximize the performance of these major stations including the optimization of revenue and private equity as well as commercial and development opportunities.

Before coming to Amtrak, Ms. Cutler was the Deputy Mayor for Transportation and Utilities for the City of Philadelphia and was responsible for the coordination and oversight of all transportation and utility functions in the City. In addition, she served on the SEPTA Board for the 5-county transit agency and on the regional MPO.

Prior to returning to Philadelphia in 2008, Ms. Cutler served for 5 years as the Deputy Secretary for Administration for the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

Ms. Cutler has extensive experience in the management and operations of major transportation systems. Her prior experience includes Transportation Commissioner for the City of Boston, and the Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic for the City of San Francisco. In 2011, American City and County Magazine named Cutler their Public Works Leader of the Year. In 2012, COMTO named Ms. Cutler as one of their Women Who Move the Nation. Ms. Cutler has served on the International Board for WTS, an organization that represents Women in the Transportation Industry.
