Mr. Mizobe is the Deputy Manager for JR East's Shinagawa and Large-scale Developments Department, which is responsible for developing the Shinagawa area and its associated terminal stations, such as Tokyo, Shinjuku, Yokohama, etc.

Mr. Mizobe joined the East Japan Railway Company (JR East) after graduating from university in 1991, and has been working with them since, and has held various positions within the organization. He also held the position of Sales Manager of Tokyo Monorail from 2005-2007 and Manager of IT & Suica Business Development Headquarters from 2009-2011.
